Each essay response must be between 200-400 words.

Two required essays:

There are two essay questions listed below (A and B). Choose **ONE** of the two to answer:

QUESTION 1:

- A. Discuss one opportunity or challenge that you've experienced during your high school career that has shaped who you are today.
- B. CNN Spotlights everyday people changing the world through its annual recognition of CNN Heroes. They're your neighbors, your friends, your colleagues, your parents – each of whom shows how one person can truly make a difference (visit www.cnn.com/specials/cnn-heroes). You too can be instrumental in making a difference. If you were to do something to change the world, what would you do and how would you go about it?

There are two essay questions listed below (A and B). Choose **ONE** of the two to answer:

QUESTION 2:

- A. Describe a problem or issue that is facing your generation. How can you and your peers make a positive, lasting impact to solve it? Be specific and use personal experiences/examples.
- B. If you could spend the day with any one person (living or deceased; real or fictional), who would it be and what would you discuss?

One optional essay:
